<b>**</b> Foster parents must notify the agency within one hour if any of the above situations occur.	
	A foster child is engaging in behavior that puts others at risk. A foster child is engaging in actions that have damaged or have the potential to damage property.
	There will be a new resident in the foster home for more than a two-week period. A fire has occurred in the home requiring assistance from the fire department. Notification must be within 24 hours or the next working day, unless the home is unlivable, in which
	case the agency must be notified immediately. There has been a change in marital status, or household occupancy, or a serious illness or death has occurred. Notification needs to occur within 24 hours or the next working day.
	The foster family is moving from one house to another. Notification needs to occur within
	4 weeks before the move occurs. Other
